In accordance with the requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act (“ICA”) and the regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission” or “FERC”), ITC Pipeline hereby submits for filing FERC No. 1.2.0, canceling FERC No. 1.1.0 (Docket No. IS17-20-000). FERC No. 1.2.0 is being issued on May 17, 2017, with a proposed effective date of May 19, 2017, which is on less than two days’ notice.

Explanation of Tariff Filings

ITC Pipeline is filing FERC No. 1.2.0 to lift the temporary embargo for movements originating from ITC Terminal and delivering to Colonial – Houston Station and to Explorer – Pasadena/Houston. During the construction of interconnecting facilities between ITC Pipeline and downstream pipelines, ITC Pipeline experienced construction delays related to weather and the location of other pipelines in the vicinity of the interconnections. ITC Pipeline and the interconnecting party stopped construction to allow time for an engineering analysis and the formulation of a safe construction plan for completion of the interconnecting facilities. ITC Pipeline filed FERC No. 1.1.0 to provide notice to all potential shippers that deliveries could not

be made to these locations until the interconnection facilities are completed and placed into service.

The engineering analysis has been completed and the interconnection facilities and pipeline system will be completed and ready for service on May 19, 2017. Accordingly, ITC Pipeline is filing the above-listed Tariff to cancel the temporary embargo for movements originating from ITC Terminal and delivering to Colonial – Houston Station and to Explorer – Pasadena/Houston effective on May 19, 2017. All rates in FERC No. 1.2.0 are unchanged from the prior tariff, as noted in the tariff.¹

Request for Special Permission

Pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 341.14 (Special Permission), ITC Pipeline requests that it be granted a waiver under Section 6(3) of the ICA to file the Tariff on less than two days' notice, so that it may become effective on May 19, 2017. ITC Pipeline submits that good cause exists for granting a waiver under Section 6(3) of the ICA. Permitting the Tariff to become effective on less than two days' notice will provide prompt notice to ITC Pipeline's shippers of the cancellation of the temporary embargo and availability of service for movements originating from ITC Terminal and delivering to Colonial – Houston Station and to Explorer – Pasadena/Houston. ITC Pipeline acknowledges that the tariff publication is conditionally accepted, subject to refund, pending a thirty-day review period.

¹ In addition to canceling the temporary embargo, ITC is revising its tariff to define the symbols used in the filing to indicate where the tariff was changed or left unchanged.
